DAY 01 | ARRIVAL IN BEIJING

Flights

For the flight-inclusive package, there are cases where customers may be required to arrive at the airport one day before their departure (Depart day 0), depending on their flight times and schedule. In certain situations, travellers may have an overnight layover, during which the airline will provide accommodation and transfers. Transfers

DAY 02 | BEIJING

After breakfast, you'll visit a **Jade Museum**, where you'll uncover the rich history of jade in Chinese culture and observe skilled craftsmen creating intricate designs. Known as "Yu" in China, jade has been revered for over four thousand years as a symbol of beauty and purity.

Following the museum tour, you'll embark on a scenic drive through picturesque countryside and mountain landscapes on your way to one of China's most iconic landmarks, **the Great Wall**. During the journey, you'll enjoy a traditional Beijing lunch with local flavors.

Upon arrival at the Great Wall, you'll explore the quieter Juyong Pass, offering a more tranquil experience away from the crowds. Spanning over 5,600 km, the Great Wall winds through northern China, showcasing both the majesty of its architecture and the stunning beauty of the surrounding landscape.

 Optional Activity: Hutong Pedicab Tour & Dinner

In the afternoon, you can opt to join an additional tour (not included, payable on-site) exploring Beijing's 700-year-old Hutongs, the city's traditional narrow alleyways, by old-fashioned pedicab. This tour includes a visit to a local family home, where you'll experience traditional customs and enjoy a delicious home-cooked meal. You'll also visit Shichahai, a historic and scenic area made up of three lakes—Qianhai, Houhai, and Xihai—surrounded by sites of historical significance, picturesque views, and remnants of old-style hutong and courtyard residences. (Please note: the optional tour is not included and requires on-site payment).



DAY 03 | BEIJING

After breakfast, you'll visit '**Tong Ren Tang**' to immerse yourself in the world of traditional Chinese medicine, learning about ancient remedies and healing practices. Next, head to **Tiananmen Square**, one of the largest public squares in the world, where you can appreciate its vast scale and deep historical significance. From there, you'll explore the Imperial Palace inside the **Forbidden City**, also known as The Palace Museum. Originally built between 1406 and 1420 during Emperor Yong Le's reign, the Forbidden City has witnessed many historical events, including fires, invasions, and restorations. The architecture you see today reflects styles from the 1700s onwards, showcasing the site's rich legacy and historical evolution.

 Optional Activity: The Golden Mask Dynasty

The Golden Mask Dynasty Show is an enchanting theatrical performance set in ancient China, featuring a blend of dance, acrobatics, and special effects, including an on-stage waterfall. Held in Beijing, the show tells the romantic and dramatic tale of a queen from the mythical Golden Mask Dynasty and her love for a rival general, beautifully weaving together themes of love, conflict, and reconciliation. Forbidden City Availability:

Due to a daily ticket limit for the Forbidden City, entry is not guaranteed and depends on availability. If tickets cannot be secured, an alternative visit to the Temple of Heaven will be arranged.

Temple of Heaven:

A UNESCO World Heritage site, the Temple of Heaven is a 15th-century complex where emperors performed rituals for good harvests. Known for its stunning altars and grand architecture, it symbolizes the connection between earth and heaven and offers a unique insight into China's cultural heritage. a unique glimpse into China's rich cultural heritage.



DAY 04 | BEIJING - WUXI

Prepare for an exciting day as you board a high-speed train to Wuxi! After an easy transfer to the railway station, you'll enjoy the thrill of traveling at impressive speeds. Upon your arrival in Wuxi, a welcoming tour representative will be there to greet you and escort you to your hotel, setting the stage for the adventures that await!

DAY 05 | WUXI - SUZHOU

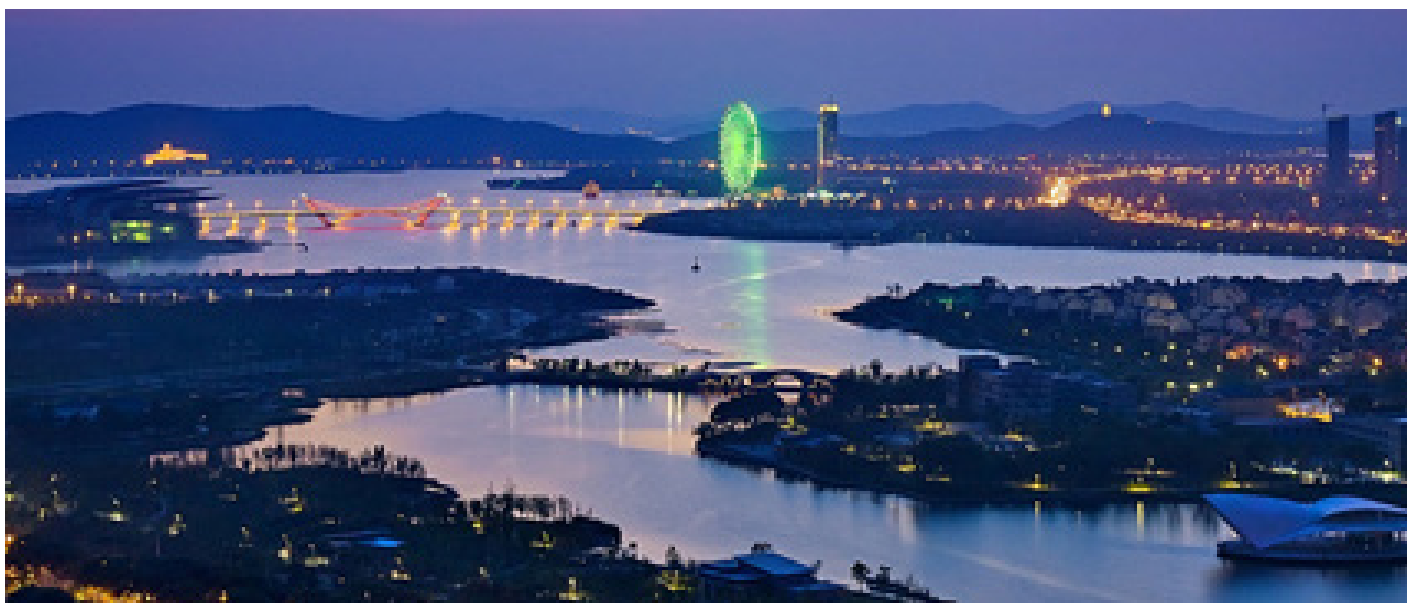

GROUP SIZE REQUIREMENT:

Bedding Configuration

Traveller Eligibilities

This program is exclusively available for adult travelers aged 18 and older. For those holding passports from countries other than Australia or New Zealand, an overseas traveler surcharge may apply. Please reach out to us for more details.

SCHEDULE OF FEES

Voluntary Changes: Changes or upgrades requested within 90 days prior to tour departure incur a fee of \$200 AUD per person per change, plus applicable supplier costs. A minimum of 48 hours notice is required. No changes permitted within 89 days of tour departure.

Cancellations & Refunds: Please note that in the event of tour cancellation fee of \$200 AUD per person will be charged, in addition to any relevant supplier cost. Refund requests must be submitted in writing and will take up to 6 weeks to process. It is important to note that no refunds can be issued once the tour has commenced (for the flight - inclusive package, no refunds can be issued once the flights have been ticketed).

Name Correction Fees: A fee of \$200 AUD per person is applicable for the name corrections on documents, along with any supplier costs. Kindly note that name corrections must be requested at least 72 hours prior to departure and are subject to approval from the supplier.

Document Change Fees: A fee of \$200 AUD per person will be charged for any passport changes, in addition to any application supplier costs. Please note that train tickets and admission access must be linked to your travel passport details. Any changes to passport information must be requested at least 14 days prior to departure and are subject to approval from the supplier.



Supplier Fees: In the event that the tour you have purchased is unable to proceed or a travel supplier is unable to fulfill the tour due to external circumstances (such as a Force Majeure event), there may be a fee or amount of money that is withheld by our suppliers and is unrecoverable. This could be due to non-refundable airline tickets, cancellation penalties with cruise cabins, or unrecoverable payments with our land/accommodation partners. As your agent, Travel China is committed to covering these costs and will make every effort to recover all funds committed and/or paid for your tour. However, please note that this may not be possible in every circumstance. If refunds are unavailable from our suppliers, we will strive to obtain a travel credit with the best possible terms and communicate these options to you. If Travel China cannot obtain a refund, travel service credit, or only a partial refund, this cost will be passed on to the customer as a supplier fee. It is important to note that this fee is not intended to generate revenue but to cover the payments our suppliers withhold during the recovery process.

Travel insurance is not included in the tour price. It is mandatory to purchase travel insurance prior to the tour departure.

By purchasing this tour, you agree to follow the listed itinerary. Any changes or no-shows may result in canceling unused bookings without a refund.

Please note that the itinerary and accommodation listed may be subject to change. We strive to communicate any changes as soon as possible, but please understand that these changes are beyond our control. Travel Documents

To ensure a smooth journey, it is imperative that you possess a valid passport and have obtained all necessary visas, permits, and certificates for the countries you plan to visit. Please note that passports are mandatory for all travelers when



departing from Australia and New Zealand. For a permanent resident to travel on a foreign passport, you must also hold an Australian/New Zealand Re-entry Visa. Additionally, many countries require foreign nationals entering their borders to possess a passport with a minimum of six months' validity. Remember, the ultimate responsibility for ensuring the accuracy of your documentation lies with you as the individual traveler. Any fines, penalties, or expenses incurred due to incorrect documentation will be solely your responsibility.

Travel Insurance

Travel insurance is a requirement for all our travelers and should be obtained at the time of booking. Your travel insurance should cover personal accidents, death, medical expenses, and emergency repatriation, with a recommended minimum coverage of US\$200,000 for each category. We also strongly recommend coverage for cancellation, curtailment, personal liability, luggage loss, and personal effects. On the first day of your trip, you must provide proof of your travel insurance. Please note that joining the trip will not be possible without it. Private Transfer

Kindly note that our standard airport transfer operates on a group basis, which may involve waiting times of up to 2 hours.
